

2025 TOLL Competitive Divisions Evaluations

Are Evaluations the same as Try Outs?

Simple answer is **NO**. The purpose of evaluations is to determine the players' skills in order to provide balanced teams during the draft process. TOLL makes every effort to build balanced teams. There are no "cuts" – every registered player will be assigned to a team and will play throughout the entire season. All coaches must attend evaluations so they can determine the players' skills and prioritize their draft preferences for their teams.

What to Expect at Evaluations

At evaluations, the player will be asked to demonstrate a series of skills designed to show their ability in fielding, throwing, catching, hitting, and running the bases.

Players must bring their own bat, glove and helmet. Please confirm the player's bat meets regulations for size/weight/etc. for the division in which they're being evaluated.

All players in Acorn I, Acorn II, Minors, Majors, and Juniors must be evaluated (yes, even those players who played in previous years must complete the evaluation)
